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a civil military relation describes the relationship between civil society as a whole and the military organization established to protect it more narrowly it describes the relationship between the civil authority of a given society and its military authority studies of civil military relations often rest on a normative assumption that civilian control of the military is preferable to military control of the state the principal problem they examine however is empirical to explain how civilian control over the military is established and maintained civil military relations are those interactions between the military and civilian actors that in

some way relate to the power to make political decisions traditionally the study of civil military relations revolved around questions of who is master and who is servant in civil military relations and who guards the guardians of the nation in other words the question of civilian control is at the heart of civil military relations even though in recent years especially with the fall of the berlin wall democratization processes in eastern europe the enlargement of the north atlantic treaty organization nato and the proliferation of peace building missions and programs in so called post conflict societies the concept of security sector governance or security sector reform has gained prominence in the academic and policy oriented literature civilian control remains the central issue in civil military relations in emerging democracies the book deeply highlights the civil military relation and its strategies

this book analyses the normative and institutional aspects of the civil military relationship to demonstrate that it is the politics of the relationship rather than its form that influences the likelihood of democracy and regional peace it is useful for policymakers academics and general readers

this book addresses the challenge of reforming defense and military policy making in newly democratized nations by tracing the development of civil military relations in various new democracies from a comparative perspective it links two bodies of scholarship that thus far have remained largely separate the study of emerging or failed civilian control over armed forces on the one hand and work on the roots and causes of military effectiveness to guarantee the protection and security of citizens on the other the empirical and theoretical findings presented here will appeal to scholars of civil military relations democratization and security issues as well as to defense policy makers

bringing together leading scholars from across the world this comprehensive research handbook analyses key problems subjects regions and countries in civil military relations showcasing cutting edge research developments it illustrates the deeply complex nature of the field and analyses important topics in need of renewed consideration

this new handbook offers a wide ranging internationally focused overview of the field of civil military relations the armed forces are central actors in most societies and are involved in many different roles amongst other activities they engage in peace operations support the police in fighting crime support civilian authorities in dealing with natural disasters and fight against terrorists and in internal conflicts the existing literature on this subject is limited in its discussion of war fighting and thus does not do justice to this variety of roles the routledge handbook of civil military relations not only fills this important lacuna but offers an up to date comparative analysis which identifies three essential components in civil military relations 1 democratic civilian control 2 operational effectiveness and 3 the efficiency of the security institutions amalgamating ideas from key

thinkers in the field the book is organized into three main parts part i development of the field of study part ii civil military relations in non democratic or nominally democratic countries part iii civil military relations in democratic and democratizing states issues and institutions this new handbook will be essential reading for students and practitioners in the fields of civil military relations defense studies war and conflict studies international security and ir in general

the topic of civil military relations has high significance for academics for policy makers for military commanders and for serious students of public policy in democratic and other societies the post cold war and post 9 11 worlds have thrown up traditional as well as new challenges to the effective management of armed forces and defense establishments further the present century has seen a rising arc in the use of armed violence on the part of non state actors including terrorists to considerable political effect civil military relations in the united states and their implications for us and allied security policies is the focus of most discussions in this volume but other contributions emphasize the comparative and cross national dimensions of the relationship between the use or threat of force and public policy authors contributing to this study examine a wide range of issues including the contrast between theory and practice in civil military relations the role perceptions of military professionals across generations the character of civil military relations in authoritarian or other democratically challenged political systems the usefulness of business models in military management the attributes of civil military relations during unconventional conflicts the experience of the all volunteer force and its meaning for us civil military relations and other topics contributors include civilian academic and policy analysts as well as military officers with considerable academic expertise and experience with the subject matter at hand

civil military cooperation has always been a key factor in both peace and conflict situations and is vital in today s political climate this indispensable volume analyzes the various types of civil military cooperation across different settings and contexts to include humanitarian operations as well as stability and reconstruction operations it offers recommendations that will be of value to both academics and practitioners

this new book addresses three key issues what has changed in chinese civil military relations what can account for changes and what are the implications for chinese security policy and strategic behaviour it tackles these questions by sharply assessing civil military dynamics in elite politics such dynamics in national security and arms control policy relations between commanders and political commissars relations between the pla and society civil military dynamics regarding defence economics and logistics and such dynamics regarding dual use technologies and defence industry these analyses build into the central theme that the emphasis of chinese civil military relations is shifting from politics to military tasks this is an extremely important new development by a nation many predict to become a super power in the twenty first century this is therefore essential reading for all students and scholars of strategic and security studies chinese studies and international relations

the relationship between civil society and the armed forces is an essential part of any polity democratic or otherwise because a military force is after all a universal feature of social systems despite significant progress moving towards democracy among some african countries in the past decade all too many african militaries have yet to accept core democratic principles regulating civilian authority over the military this book explores the theory of civil military relations and moves on to review the intrusion of the armed forces in african politics by looking first into the organization and role of the army in pre colonial and colonial eras before examining contemporary armies and their impact on society furthermore it revisits the various explanations of military takeovers in africa and disentangles the notion of the military as the modernizing force whether as a revolutionary force as a stabilizing force or as a modernizing force the military has often been perceived as the only organized and disciplined group with the necessary skills to uplift newly independent nations the performance of africa s military governments since independence however has soundly disproven this thesis as such this study conveys the necessity of new civil military relations in africa and calls not just for civilian control of the military but rather a democratic oversight of the security forces in africa

in this carefully researched study coy reexamines the notion of the military as an effective contributor to the process of political modernization in developing countries testing theories of civil military relations against descriptions and analyses of events in sierra leone the author offers explanations that are original and that make this book a model micro study

civil military relations describe the interactions and balance of power between the civilians and the military in a nation state due to the organizational apparatus and capacity for forcible coercion that the military possesses it can be an important determinant on whether a civilian government survives or falls as well as what policies are formulated and implemented this thesis analyses southeast asian civil military relations in a comparative perspective by looking at seven states in the region thailand indonesia singapore malaysia the philippines vietnam and myanmar it finds a rich diversity of such relations ranging from situations of civilian control to civil military partnerships to military control the thesis therefore aims to answer the question why has there been this variance in civil military relations in the region the thesis first examines briefly the history of civil military relations theory as well as the history of the seven states mentioned above building an analytical framework and proposing three alternative explanations for variance firstly it asserts that pre independence legacies created path dependencies that structure the shape of civil military relations in the region secondly the thesis argues that the structure of the political party environment mattered and assesses the case studies through indicators of concordance and discordance finally the thesis looks at the presence of military entrepreneurship asserting that variance depends on military capacity to engage in external business activities and civilian willingness to allow such activities the thesis concludes by assessing the explanatory power of the three factors above and concluding that a combination of pre independence legacies and party structure best explains civil military relations in the region
